EUROCHAMBRES declaration of European recovery strategy

On the occasion of their 28 April 2020 video conference, members of the EUROCHAMBRES Presidency emphasised the perilous state of many businesses as a consequence of the dramatic economic slowdown since early March. They welcomed EU level financial liquidity measures already adopted, but underlined the importance of building on these and ensuring that they are implemented flexibly and without delay.

The Presidency also reiterated the need for an ambitious, swift and effective COVID-19 European recovery strategy. Referring to EUROCHAMBRES' submission to the 23 April European Council, the Presidency highlighted three pre-requisites for a robust response to this extraordinary crisis: restoring supply and productivity, ensuring the free movement of goods, workers and services, and reviving demand.

EUROCHAMBRES considers that the EU has a vital role to play in the recovery effort. The European network of 1.700 Chambers across 43 countries is resolutely committed to support the business community and to restoring Europe's economy.
